

Instructions for Fringe Presser Foot

See your sewing machine instruction manual for stitch guide



The Fringe Foot is used to create three-dimensional texture on fabrics, producing a fringe effect.

Machine Preparation

- Remove the presser foot and presser foot holder. Attach the Fringe Foot.
- Tighten the thumb screw securely.
- Apply stabilizer behind the fabric, to prevent the stitches from tunneling in.

Eyelash Fringe

- 1. Set the machine for an Overcast or Overedge Stitch. Select the widest width setting, but a short length setting. Turn the hand wheel toward you slowly, to make sure that the needle clears the foot.
- 2. Draw a line where you want the left swing of the needle to sew.
- 3. After sewing the row of stitches, slide the fringe off the foot, toward the back. To create an eyelash effect, use a sharply pointed scissor to trim the thread loops close to the fabric on the right-hand side of the loops. Lightly brush the threads with your finger or a toothbrush on both sides of the fabric.

Loops Intact Fringe

- 1. Select ZigZag Stitch. Set the stitch width according to the look you want for your project. Set the stitch length for a short setting (about 1mm). Turn the hand wheel toward you slowly, to make sure that the needle clears the foot.
- 2. Sew several rows next to one another as desired. Remove the presser foot and presser foot holder. Attach the Fringe Foot. Tighten the thumb screw securely.

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
